Maundy Thursday – March 24

5:30 PM Maundy Thursday is part of what's called the Triduum, or three holy days before Easter.

On this day, we will observe a foot washing ceremony, and we remember the Last Supper.

Good Friday – March 25, Noon and 5:30 PM

The Friday before Easter Day, the day in which the Church commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus is a time of fasting and special acts of discipline and self-denial. It is among the most sober of days of the church calendar. On this day, among other readings, the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ is read from John's Gospel, the Solemn Collects, which are an ancient form of intercessory prayer (dating from ancient Rome) are said along with devotions before the cross (commonly known as the veneration of the cross). The service concludes with the administering of Holy Communion from the reserved sacrament set aside on Maundy Thursday.



Holy Saturday - March 26, Easter Vigil 7:30 PM

The Great Vigil, when observed, is the first service of Easter Day. It is celebrated sometime between sunset on Holy Saturday and sunrise on Easter Morning. The service normally consists of four parts:

1. The Service of Light.
2. The Service of Lessons.
3. Christian Initiation, or the Renewal of Baptismal Vows.
4. The Holy Eucharist with the administration of Easter Communion.
